
#### Fashion meets art: invitation to the art show 2024

Fit 4 Life: a programme that has been strengthening our students for 18 years

The Fit 4 Life programme has been running at iDSB's primary and secondary schools for 18 years. The programme focuses on different topics at each grade level.

Dr Wernig was previously responsible for coordinating this programme. Her successor is now Vera Aubrée, who will be starting as a French and geography teacher in February after her maternity leave and is already organising Fit 4 Life in the first half of the year.

As part of the Fit 4 Life programme, a number of training sessions on the topics of self-confidence, addiction prevention, media skills and sexual education will take place again this year. The **1st and 3rd grades** will start in primary school from 4 to 7 November on the topic of 'strong souls - strong children'. The focus of this training is on various key areas, including promoting social skills, strengthening self-confidence, effective conflict resolution, preventing bullying, setting personal boundaries and dealing consciously with communication.

On 4 and 5 November, the **7th and 9th grades** at the secondary school took part in the 'Falling in love with safety' training with a team of medical students from Munich. The colleagues withdraw in order to offer the pupils a safe space together with the young students.

The focus for Year 7 pupils is on the basics of anatomy, the female cycle and contraception, with these basics being repeated again in Year 9, with additional information being provided by the medical students.

We will inform you about the contents of grades 5, 6, 8 and 10 in the December newsletter.


