Arriving and leaving school safely

In order to ensure a smooth process and the safety of our children in the **Kiss & Ride Zone**, we ask you to observe the following instructions:

Staff car park primary school/high school:

- Please do not use the staff car park to drop off or pick up your children.

Speed:

- Reduce your speed to walking pace throughout the school grounds.


Stopping/parking:

- The kiss & ride zone is not a parking zone. Not even for just a few minutes.
- Please use the car park in front of the school if your child's arrival is delayed or if you need to get out or you need to get out of the car.
- No cars stop in the security zone (= waiting area for pupils, next to the canopy).
- Please keep the taxi zone free for taxis only.

Arrival of your children by car:

- Always drive as far forward as possible (see solid line at the end of the Kiss & Ride zone) before letting your children out of the car.

- Pay attention to the safety of our pupils, especially when leaving the car park.

Germany: Federal election 2025

Liebe Familien aus Deutschland,

nachstehend eine Information der Deutschen Botschaft Ihnen zur Kenntnis.

Dear Sir or Madam,

We have received numerous enquiries due to the developments in Berlin. It is now possible to register on theelectoral roll for an upcoming Bundestag election in 2025 and thus also apply for postal voting documents. Inview of the presumably shortened deadlines, it is even advisable to do this as soon as possible.

The following applies:

- 1. Germans who are no longer registered/deregistered in Germany are not automatically entered on theelectoral roll, but only on application.
- 2. The relevant current application forms and information on registration in the voters' register were published by the Federal Returning Officer on 8 November 2024 on her website at https://www.bundeswahlleiterin.de/mitteilungen/bundestagswahlen/2025/20241108_mitteilung_AD.html
- 3. The Federal Returning Officer recommends sending the application for entry in the electoral roll to themunicipal authority as early as possible.
- 4. Applications can be sent directly to the electoral offices in the municipalities with immediate effect.
