

We are pleased to announce that we will be offering our first parent-child gymnastics program for children up to the age of 4 after the Easter vacations! **Every Wednesday from 16:00 to 17:00**, we invite you to become playfully active together with your children. Our first meeting will take place on **April 30, 2025**. Please note that there will be no gymnastics during the vacations and on May 28th and July 9th.

- One visit per meeting will be noted on the card.

Fit4life: Students strengthen their media skills and addiction prevention

On **31.03.** and **01.04.2025**, we will be hosting Addiction Help Eupen as part of the Fit4life program. Training sessions will take place in the 6th, 8th and 9th grades. The **6th graders** will receive a unit on the topics of media consumption and smartphones, whereby the students will be informed about the different media uses and educated about the risks and dangers of the virtual world. There is also a focus on raising awareness of the phenomenon of online addiction.

Alcohol consumption and its effects are discussed in the **8th grade**. So-called intoxication goggles are also used during the training. These simulate the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substances on the brain. The participants have to master various tasks, such as unlocking a lock, searching for coins, catching a ball, running a slalom, etc. The first run takes place "sober", the second with impairment through the intoxication goggles.

In the **9th grade**, the focus is on addiction prevention and the students go through an exercise that provides an overview of legal, illegal, substance- and non-substance-related addictive substances. The participants learn about everyday addictive substances. They realize that the topic of "addiction" encompasses more than hashish or heroin.
